Start praying

- Someone open with prayer
- Begin with a time of individual prayer over the 3 prayers:
 - Search Me
 - Break Me
 - Send Me

Allow time for God to speak to the group

- Share anything that God spoke to you for yourself or for the group

Pray one for another

- Talk about the needs of the group or pray for a burden shared by someone in the group
- Pray for healing for body, mind, soul, or spirit
